

**PROCEEDINGS OF MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, LOUISIANA
TUESDAY, DECEMBER 10, 2024 – 5:00 P.M.**

The Town Council of Oak Grove met in regular session on Tuesday, December 10, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. in the council chambers at City Hall. Present for the meeting were Council Members Nevels, Walker, Allen, Holland and Phillips. Mayor Rollinson presided.

Invocation was led by Council Member Allen.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve the minutes of the November 12 2024 meeting. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips to approve the November 2024 financials and bills for payment. The motion carried.

The Clerk stated that the insurance agency was only able to get one company to quote for auto, general liability, fire, law enforcement and public official insurance. The quote had not been turned in at the time of the meeting but was expected to be turned in the next day. Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland, to give the mayor the authority to accept the quote whenever it is turned in. The motion carried.

At 5:03 p.m. Council Member Nevels made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to enter executive session and asked that Chance Grubbs remain in the room for the executive session. The motion carried.

At 5:12 p.m. Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips to return to regular session. The motion carried.

The council had been presented with an invoice from Chance Grubbs on behalf of G5 Farms, LLC for costs associated with the loss of cows due to the water service being turned off to the pasture. Council Member Nevels made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips, to have the water department pay the full amount of the invoice in the amount of \$16,725.00. The motion carried.

At 5:14 p.m. Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to adjourn. The motion carried.
