PROCEEDINGS OF MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, LOUISIANA TUESDAY, MARCH 8, 2022 – 4:30 P.M.

The Town Council of Oak Grove met in regular session on Tuesday, March 9, 2022 at 4:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Present for the meeting were Council Members Nevels, Gammill, Walker, Allen and Dunnahoe. Mayor Holland Presided.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Dunnahoe to approve a quote from Red Pest Control to treat fire ants in the park for \$425.00 and the cemetery for \$425.00. The motion carried.

Council Member Dunnahoe made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve having truck seats in units 7 and 21 reupholstered at a fee of \$500 per truck for a total of \$1,000.00. The motion carried.

Council Member Gammill made a motion, seconded by Council Member Nevels to approve a Memorandum of Understanding with the West Carroll Parish School Board for the implementation of a School Resource Officer Program. The motion carried.

Council Member Dunnahoe made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve Jeff Moody to attend upcoming certification classes for sewer as well as for Obadiah Rouse to attend upcoming certification classes for water and approve amending Obadiah Rouse's employment contract from .50 cents to .84 cents per hour pay increase with the achievement of each level of certification. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Dunnahoe to adjourn at 4:44 p.m. The motion carried.
